COMMON THREADS

All the pillows
Bridgid chose share
organic-looking
patterns (no hard
edges) and the same
deep orange color.

TWINSIES

Nestle two of the same pillows together to anchor the back row.

SHAPE SHIFTER

Add a lumbar (aka kidney) pillow. It's an exclamation point among all the squares.

CONTROLLED COLOR

To zing up the orange palette, Bridgid threw in small hits of its color-wheel neighbors: yellow and brick red.

Mix materials like linen, pleated cotton, and embroidery for a sofa scape that engages the senses.

BOOKENDS

Alternate patterns and solids in a (more or less) symmetrical arrangement. Land the boldest pattern at the ends of the sofa.
